Common Abbreviations Used in Crochet

CH - Chain

SC - Single Crochet

DC - Double Crochet

HDC - Half Double Crochet

TR or TRC - Treble Crochet

Lesson #1 -

Simple, basic dishcloth Chain stitch, turn work, sc across

Lesson #2 -

Matching Tea Towel adding the double crochet (DC) Chain stitch, turn work, dc across

Lesson #3 -

A simple project to practice combining two different types of stitches. Chain stitch, turn work, one row sc, one row dc. Repeat this for 28 rows ending on a wrong side row. Can mark front of work with stitch marker or safety pin upon completion of row 1.

Lesson #4 -

Reading a pattern

Use a simple dishcloth pattern to start (or a project determined by group) Read the pattern row by row. Participants follow along.

Lesson #5 -

Progress to a harder level of pattern reading.

Project to be determined. Continue on with harder levels of crochet. Include how to make a swatch for gauge.

Lesson #6

Make a wearable of your choice. I will be your support person if you run into any problems. A wearable can be a sweater, poncho, etc......
